GOSPEL CULTURE: SATISFIED Text: Isaiah 55:1-7

God invites everyone into a satisfying covenant, but many prefer the world and reject His divine invitation.

INVITATION:

- 1) WHO'S INVITED? Isaiah 55:1a
 - a) **THE THIRSTY**: God cares for the thirsty Hosea 13:5. See also: John 4:10,13-14
 - b) THE BROKE:
 - i) God owns EVERYTHING Exodus 19:5, Psalm 50:12, Haggai 2:8
 - ii) Only the BROKE recognize they have NOTHING to offer God

 Romans 6:23
- 2) WHAT'S BEING SERVED? 55:1b
 - a) **WATER**: God offers water to REFRESH the thirsty Isaiah 48:21, Psalm 23:2-3
 - b) MILK: God offers milk for Christians to GROW 1 Peter 2:2
 - c) WINE: God offers wine for JOY Ecclesiastes 9:7
- 3) WHAT ARE WE BEING INVITED TO? REPENTANCE Isaiah 55:6-7
 - a) Repentance produces **REFRESHMENT** Acts 3:19
 - b) Repentance produces FRUIT Matthew 3:8
 - c) Repentance is an invitation into deeper **JOY**

INVITATION REJECTION:

- 1) We all want to **REJECT** the invite and give **LAME EXCUSES** Luke 14:18-20
 - Lame excuse 1: I have house work
 - Lame excuse 2: I have to work on my truck/tractor
 - Lame excuse 3: My spouse/significant other won't let me
- 2) We **LABOR** for **DISSATISFACTION** Isaiah 55:2a. See Also: Ecclesiastes 1:14
- 3) APART from God, we will remain DISSATISFIED Ecclesiastes 2:25
- 4) **A STERN WARNING**: Eventually, God retracts the invite and leaves us Isaiah 55:6, Luke 14:24, Matthew 21:43, Matthew 22:13

INVITATION ACCEPTANCE: David's Covenant – Isaiah 55:3b,4 – Isaiah was talking about **JESUS** – John 12:37-43

- 1) WITNESS: A witness proclaims, but also has outward transformation
- 2) **LEADER**: The leader is the greatest servant Luke 22:26-29
- 3) **COMMANDER:** Commanders first join in suffering and please Christ 2 Timothy 2:3-4, Luke 16:10

BE SATISFIED:

- 1) OUR satisfaction is to ACCOMPLISH the WILL of God John 4:34
- 2) **RESPOND** to God Isaiah 55:5
- 3) God's GRACE is GREATER Isaiah 55:7b

Gospel In Life Questions

- 1) **BELIEVE:** WHAT TRUTHS did God REVEAL to me through His Word today about HIM and/or MYSELF?
- 2) ASSESS: HOW do these truths ENCOURAGE and/or CHALLENGE (convict) ME?
- 3) **PROCESS:** WHY is this message GOOD NEWS (GOSPEL) to ME today? (CONNECT the GOSPEL story to MY present story)
- 4) **CHANGE:** WHERE will I APPLY (BELIEVE, REPENT, DO) this message in MY own life this week?
- 5) **PROCLAIM:** WHO does God want ME to share these truths with this week?
